## Week Three | Luke - To the Inquisitive | 03.28-29.2020

**Grow Deep Conversation Questions:** Use these questions to help you process the message in your personal time of study or with your group. Time suggestions are based on a 90 minute group gathering.

**Message Recap:** Luke was not Jewish and only knew of Jesus because of someone else. But he loved all the details and wanted to be sure his gospel account included as much information as possible by interviewing eye-witnesses and spending time with those who had known him personally.

### » Opening

(2-3 minutes)

- Introductions - this is especially important if this is your first meeting and if there are new members
- Housekeeping - clarify expectations
  - **Announcements:** These are in your Community News email. **Please read and communicate! Encourage participation!**
  - Remind your group that this is a confidential meeting
  - **Remember there may be many thoughts and views. Please remain kind and respectful during conversations.**
- Pray - open your time together in prayer

### » Introduction

(12 minutes)

- Ice-Breaker: When taking a photograph, do you prefer to zoom in on one thing or capture the wide view?
- Digging Deeper: What are the positives and negatives of each photography preference?

### » Observation | Read Luke 1:1-4, 9:21-26, 23:26

(12 minutes)

- What are your initial reactions to these passages? What do you find challenging? Are you encouraged by any of these verses? Why?

### » Key Principle | Zoom in on Jesus to widen your view.

(12 minutes)

- When thinking about who Jesus is, how do you think most people who don't follow Jesus approach Him - zoomed in or wide-view?
- What might be missing if we are zooming in on something or someone other than Jesus?

### » The More You Know | Reference Luke 1:1-4

(12 minutes)

- Luke spent time learning and testing the information he had access to in order to know Jesus, how do you get to know Jesus?
- How is your relationship with Jesus connected to how you view others?

### » Life Interrupted | Reference Luke 23:26

(12 minutes)

- What do we know about Simon? How might this one moment have changed Simon's life?
- Would you consider yourself "interruptible?" How has your life been interrupted recently? What can happen in an interruption?

### » Carry the Cross, Daily | Reference Luke 9:21-26

(12 minutes)

- What does it mean to "carry the cross?" What does this look like in your life?
- How can you use this time to get to know Jesus and share Him with others, even now?

### » Next Steps and Prayer |

(15minutes)

- What mission of Jesus convicts you in our modern world? What holds you back from living out your passions and convictions?
- Close by praying for each other, our community and our world to see Jesus, even in the middle of difficulties and uncertainties.
