# Message Recap:

# Opening Introductions - this is especially important if this is your first meeting and if there are new members

## » Introduction

- Ice-Breaker: In one word, how would you define the word "church?"
- Digging Deeper: How do you think about 'before Jesus' in your life if you became a Christian very young?

#### >> Observation | Read Ephesians 2:1-10

• What are your initial reactions to this passage? What do you find challenging? Are you encouraged by any of these verses? Why?

# » Key Principle | What if we bowed instead of staying proud?

- What are the reasons you have or have heard for why people walked away from church? What do you notice about these reasons?
- How does pride prevent people from seeing Jesus?

#### **The Walking Dead** | Reference Ephesians 2:1-3

- Paul is writing to a church reminding them of who they were before they met Jesus. Why is this important?
- If you were a holy God, what would you do with the people that were described by Paul in these first three verses?

## **Divine Intervention** | Reference Ephesians 2:4-7

- Have you ever been caught red-handed and not been punished?
- What does the following statement mean? God had to look at Jesus and see us and our sin on the cross so that he can look at us and see Jesus. Why is this such a powerful statement?

## » No Bragging Rights | Reference Ephesians 2:8-10

- God's mercy and love intervened in our lives on purpose and to give us a purpose; how does your life show that purpose right now?
- What are the 'good works' Jesus has prepared for you to do right now?
- What are the bragging rights of your life that you need to give up so you can live a life that reflects who Jesus is to those around you?

# » Next Steps and Prayer |

- How can you humble yourself and find a way to help someone in this time when people are struggling in so many ways?
- Close by praying for each other to reflect Jesus and for our community who have been hurt by church to see who Jesus really is in us.
