Observation | Read Matthew 16:13-20; Ephesians 2:19-22

Xey Principle | Our mission started before us and will outlive us.

- Define the mission of the Church in your own way. In what ways do you find yourself living out this mission?
- We are all on a mission. What are some of the "missions" you see people on today? How do these "missions" line up with God's mission for the Church? What are some similarities and differences?

The Moving Rock | Reference Matthew 16:13-20

- How do you hope people describe you now and after you have passed away? Explain the words you chose.
- The church has always been God's Plan A for the world. According to Jesus, what is it built on top of in our life?
- How does your perspective need to change in terms of what the church is for?

The Eternal Cornerstone | Reference Ephesians 2:19-22

- How do you measure success in life? Describe what this looks like for you and those around you?
- What is a cornerstone, and why is Jesus referred to as that?
- If you are truly a temple of the Holy Spirit, how is He calling you to change your life to join the mission of the church?

Next Steps and Prayer |

- How will you re-engage in the mission God has called us all to? What are some practical steps you can take this week to become more involved in what we are all called to do?
- Close by praying for each other to take a next step in the mission God is calling them to.
