



## Week Two | Sing - Calling | 07.03-04.2021

**Grow Deep Conversation Questions:** Use these questions to help you process the message in your personal time of study or with your group. Time suggestions are based on a 90-minute group gathering.

**Message Recap:** Sing follows a group of unlikely characters who are exploring the calling they have felt but never realized. The movie highlights a very important principle we find in the Bible that our unique calling takes initiative to explore. We aren't guaranteed an outcome but we are promised God's presence and purpose in the middle of the pursuit.

### » Opening (2-3 minutes)

- Introductions - this is especially important if this is your first meeting and if there are new members
- Housekeeping - clarify expectations
  - Remind your group that this is a confidential meeting
  - **Remember there may be many thoughts and views. Please remain kind and respectful during conversations.**
- Pray - open your time together in prayer

### » Introduction (12 minutes)

- Digging Deeper: What are your top 3 Spiritual Gifts? What are some ways you can see yourself using your gifts to serve others?

### » Observation | Read Ephesians 4:1-16 (12 minutes)

- What are your initial reactions to this passage? What do you find challenging? Are you encouraged by any of these verses? Why?

### » Key Principle | Moving from consuming to contributing is our calling. (12 minutes)

- Paul has a powerful story of being invited to follow Jesus after he did some awful things. What from your past can convince you that you aren't worthy of God's love or calling?

### » Let's spread the word right away. | Reread Ephesians 4:1-6 (12 minutes)

- Paul lists a number of things we are universally called to in Jesus; which come most naturally to you and which ones are the most challenging?

### » Don't let fear stop you from doing the thing you love. | Reread Ephesians 4:7-13 (12 minutes)

- The gifts that Paul mentions are just a sample of those that we can be given by God, take the attached assessment and share your results.

### » There's only one way left to go. | Reread Ephesians 4:14-16 (12 minutes)

- Where has your past held you back from stepping into God's calling for your life?

### » Next Steps and Prayer | (15 minutes)

- Where could you serve in a primary or secondary calling in this season? What are you passionate about, and where are you needed?
- Close by praying for each other to find a way to step out and allow God to work through you to use your gifts to serve others.
