



Week Three | Into the Spider-Verse - Leap of Faith | 07.10-11.2021

Grow Deep Conversation Questions: Use these questions to help you process the message in your personal time of study or with your group. Time suggestions are based on a 90-minute group gathering.

Message Recap: Miles Morales finds himself with quickly maturing superpowers and a dysfunctional supporting cast to help him save the world. Throughout the movie, he fails to take the leap until he finally experiences something new on the other side of his faith. The Bible paints a picture of us taking a leap of faith too, not in ourselves, but in God because of Jesus. We'll explore how we take that leap today.

» Opening (2-3 minutes)

- Introductions - this is especially important if this is your first meeting and if there are new members
- Housekeeping - clarify expectations
 - Remind your group that this is a confidential meeting
 - **Remember there may be many thoughts and views. Please remain kind and respectful during conversations.**
- Pray - open your time together in prayer

» Introduction (12 minutes)

- Ice-Breaker: Who's your favorite superhero? What makes them your favorite one?
- Digging Deeper: What are some lessons we can learn from superheroes?

» Observation | Read Hebrews 11:1-40 (12 minutes)

- What are your initial reactions to this passage? What do you find challenging? Are you encouraged by any of these verses? Why?

» Key Principle | With great power comes great responsibility. (12 minutes)

- Where are some places you feel God has given you great power? What kind of responsibilities does this power bring?

» It's a leap of faith. | Reread Hebrews 11:1-3 (12 minutes)

- In how faith is defined in verses 1-3, what future hope does your faith rest in?
- Where is God asking you to take a leap? How can your group help you take that leap of faith? What will it take to follow through?

» I think you're gonna be a bad teacher. | Reread Hebrews 11:4-38 (12 minutes)

- This passage is referred to as the 'hall of faith' who are the people that you are most familiar with and least familiar with?
- Pick one person from this section that you don't know as well. Look up their story and discuss why they would be included here.

» Always get back up. | Reread Hebrews 11:39-40 (12 minutes)

- Where do you need a new perspective that God is showing you?
- What stands out to you from this passage and how faith has always played the key role in God's people, even before Jesus' earthly ministry?

» Next Steps and Prayer | (15 minutes)

- What are the things that hold you back from taking a leap, allowing yourself to trust God?
- Close by praying for each other to remember that God loves them infinitely and intimately and wants you to take a leap of faith.
