Grow Deep Conversation Questions: Use these questions to help you process the message in your personal time of study or with your group. Time suggestions are based on a 90-minute group gathering.

- Pray Open your time together in prayer.

 Covenants are Sacrifical/Contracts are Self-Serving Reread Ephesians 5:25-33 God's design for humanity and marriage seems much different than where we have drifted. Where in your mind or your marriage have you let contract thinking leak in? 	(12 minutes) personal
Covenants are Permanent/Contracts are Temporary Reread Matthew 19:1-12	(12 minutes)
