

Week Two | Relationship | 10.05-06.2019

Grow Deep Conversation Questions: Use these questions to help you process the message in your personal time of study or with your group. Time suggestions are based on a 90 minute group gathering.

Message Recap: Conflict is hard, but when we avoid it, life gets ever harder. Many times it feels easier to avoid a difficult conversation, but conflict doesn't go away, instead it just gets worse - like old food in the refrigerator.

>> Opening (2-3 minutes)

- Introductions this is especially important if this is your first meeting and if there are new members
- Housekeeping clarify expectations
 - Announcements: These are in your Community News email. Please read and communicate! Encourage participation!
 - Remind your group that this is a confidential meeting.
 - Remember there may be many thoughts and views. Please remain kind and respectful during conversations.
- Pray open your time together in prayer

> Introduction (15 minutes)

- Ice-Breaker: How do you handle conflict? Do you jump right in or run and avoid?
- Digging Deeper: Why do you think you respond to conflict in that way?
- >>> Observation | Read Matthew 18:15

(12 minutes)

- What are your initial reactions to this passage? What is encouraging or challenging? Why? What do you notice about God?
- Lie #2 | I can belong and bottle up.

(10 minutes)

- What types of relationships do you tend to let things bottle up with? How has bottling up past offenses hurt present relationships?
- **Go Directly** | Reread Matthew 18:15a

(10 minutes)

- Instead of going directly to someone, what do we do? What are the benefits of going to someone directly and privately?
- Tell Honestly | Reread Matthew 18:15b; Galatians 6:1

(10 minutes)

- What prevents us from honestly pointing out how we have been wronged? How would you prefer someone to approach you?
- >>> Forgive Generously | Reread Matthew 18:15bc; Matthew 18:32-33

(10 minutes)

- How do you respond when someone asks for forgiveness? What happens when the relationship is leveraged and put on probation?
- Truth #2 | Jesus makes life better...together in any weather |

(10 minutes)

- Do you have people you care enough about to have a difficult conversation with rather than abandon the relationship?
- >> Closing and Prayer |

(10 minutes)

- What are you bottling up, carrying around, and not dealing with? Who do you need to talk to this week?
- Close by praying for one another to courageously uncover the past hurts that are preventing you from moving into reconciliation.
