TRIP DATES

July 13 - July 25, 2022

TRIP COST

- \$3,000.00 per person

TRIP REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years or older (over 16 years if accompanied by a parent or guardian)
- Must submit a \$2,000 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit by MARCH 6TH
- Must complete the Village of Hope application
- Must have a valid passport 6 months beyond the end date of the trip by MARCH 6TH
- Must complete medical waivers and vaccination
- Must attend bi-monthly team meeting
- Must adhere to proper dress code





THIS TRIP INCLUDES

- Round-trip airfare from Denver to Zambia
- All transportation while on the trip
- All housing while on the trip
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner at the Village of Hope
- Visa to enter Zambia
- Trip flight insurance
- Zambia T-Shirt

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED

- Personal expenses, souvenirs, gifts
- Lunches on days we go to Lusaka
- Your personal health insurance.
- Your required medications, shots, and vaccinations

TRIP PACKAGE

MISSION ZAMBIA COUNT DOWN

- Informational Meetings (attend one)

 - February 6th
- Village of Hope application and the \$2,000.00 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit are due on March 6th
- Team meetings
 - March 6th
 - April 3rd
 - May 1st
 - June 5th
 - July 3rd
 - July 10th or 11th - Packing Day
 - July 13 - Departure to Zambia
 - July 25th - Return to Denver





WHAT TO BRING?

- Bible
- Notebook/pen
- Personal hygiene items (toothbrush, paste, etc.)
- Personal medications (allergy meds,
- Travel alarm
- Flashlight (**Very important)
- Small knapsack to use on daily trips
- Neck pillow for the long flights
- Hats-wide brim for sun protection
- Sunscreen, sunglasses, lotion
- Small containers of travel hand sanitizer
- 2-3 Packets of laundry soap depending on your length of stay for washing clothes (usually by hand)
- Snacks (power bars, candy bars or nuts in small Ziploc snack bags.)
- Water bottle
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Consider bringing your own towel and sheets (single bed size). If you are able to then leave them and donate to the ministry.

PACKING LIST

DO I NEED TO ATTEND ANY MEETINGS?

- Yes. All team meetings are required.

IS IT SAFE IN ZAMBIA?

- Yes. Zambia is a peaceful, friendly country that welcomes all visitors.

DO I NEED A PASSPORT?

- Yes. Passports **MUST** be valid for 6 months beyond the end date of the trip. If you don't have one or if you need to renew, please do so immediately.

DO I NEED A VISA?

Yes. You'll need a visa to enter Zambia.

WHAT'S THE LUGGAGE COST FOR AIRFARES?

- You are allowed one carry-on bag for free.
- You are also allowed one check-in bag for free that is 50 lbs or less.
- Bags in excess of 50 lbs or any additional bags will incur additional fees at the expense of the traveler(s).
- Pack light. All participants will be required to carry their own luggage.

WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE?

- Our trip will be during the dry season but it will be winter. Layering is advised.
 - Ladies your shoulders must be covered, dresses and skirts should be below the knee.
- Other requirements will be covered during our team meetings.

DO I NEED HEALTH INSURANCE?

- Yes, we highly recommend it. Please contact your current health insurance provider. When asking please verify that your insurance coverage extends beyond U.S. borders. For example, Medicaid and Medicare do not cover international coverage. As such, we recommend purchasing supplemental health care coverage for the duration of the trip.

DO I NEED ANY VACCINATIONS?

- Yes. Details will be covered during our team meetings.

WILL I NEED TO EXCHANGE MONEY?

- Yes. You can exchange money at the Zambia airport when we arrive.

HOW CAN I COMMUNICATE BACK TO THE U.S.?

- Please check with your phone provider to see what services and rates are available to you. All costs will be your individual responsibility.

DOES THE CHURCH SPONSOR OR HELP PARTICIPANTS PAY FOR THEIR TRIP?

- No, the church does not help support individuals on the trip at this time. We can provide sample fundraising for personal fundraising.
